**WHEREAS**, the CITY OF SELMA is the recipient of a 2009 Community Development Block Grant Number CDR-LR-09-011 from the State of Alabama for road improvements; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City did advertise for Request for Proposals for engineering services in the Selma Times-Journal and the Montgomery Advertiser on August 20, 2009 and August 27, 2009; and has determined that the Proposal for Engineering Services submitted by Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood is the most acceptable; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City has complied fully with the procurement requirements as set forth in O.M.B. Circular A-102 Attachment O, and the Common Rule as adopted by the State of Alabama, *and*

**WHEREAS**, George P. Evans in his capacity as Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood in the amount of \$54,600.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Patrick Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc. to perform Engineering services for the City of Selma J.L. Chestnut Street Reconstruction Project as set forth in its proposal.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the incurred expenses of the agreement are obligated in the 2009 Community Development Block Grant.


